Advisory Opinion on April 19, 2010

The Commission considered the facts that were provided regarding the sale of advertising to local businesses in the Senior Times to raise funds for a project of the Commission on Aging and any potential conflict that might exist pursuant to with the County Public Ethics Law.

The Commission determined that there would not be a violation of the County Public Ethics Law, because there is no conflict of interest or an appearance of a conflict of the County Public Ethics Law, under any subsection of § 8- 11. The advertising is not determined to be a gift, as it is billing for services provided, so further there is no violation of §8-12.
