Advisory Opinion Issued on August 20, 2007 to Amend
Advisory Opinion Issued on July 16, 2007

The Commission considered additional facts that were provided after issuing an advisory opinion on July 16, 2007 regarding an employee of Queen Anne's County and a conflict of interest he had with secondary employment with other organizations that had, in the past, received funding from his Department. The additional information stated that currently no financial or programmatic connection existed between the Queen Anne's County Partnership for Children and Families and For All Seasons or Mid-Shore Council on Family Violence. The Commission determined that as long as his County employment does not involve programs or services that are in the areas in which he provides counseling as his secondary employment, it would not violate the Conflict of Interest section of the Queen Anne's County Public Ethics Law.
